SAINT FAUSTINA: canonized April 30, 2000 by Pope John Paul II; brought us the Divine Mercy Devotion

SAINT MAXIMILIAN: canonized Oct 10, 1989 by Pope John Paul II; volunteered to die in place of a stranger in the German death camp of Auschwitz, located in German-occupied Poland during World War II. He was active in promoting the veneration of the Immaculate Virgin Mary

SAINT JOHN PAUL II: canonized April 27, 2014 by Pope Francis; everyone knows John Paul II: his face, his characteristic way of moving and speaking; his immersion in prayer and his spontaneous cheerfulness. Many of his words have become indelibly engraved in our memories, starting with the passionate cry with which he introduced himself to the people at the beginning of his pontificate: 'Open wide the doors to Christ, and be not afraid of him!'

The evening will start with an engaging talk by Peggy and Keith followed by veneration of the relics.
